

WHAT IS TRINITY SUNDAY?

Trinity Sunday, the first Sunday after Pentecost, honors the Holy Trinity—the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Although the word "trinity" does not appear in Scripture, it is taught in Matthew 28:18-20 and 2 Corinthians 13:14 (and many other biblical passages). It lasts only one day, which is symbolic of the unity of the Trinity. Western Christians have observed the Sunday after Pentecost as a time to pause and reflect on the Christian understanding of God.




LOUIS C. MCCONAUGHY FUND SCHOLARSHIPS




