Listen to the words of God in the Torah and hear them speak to you."

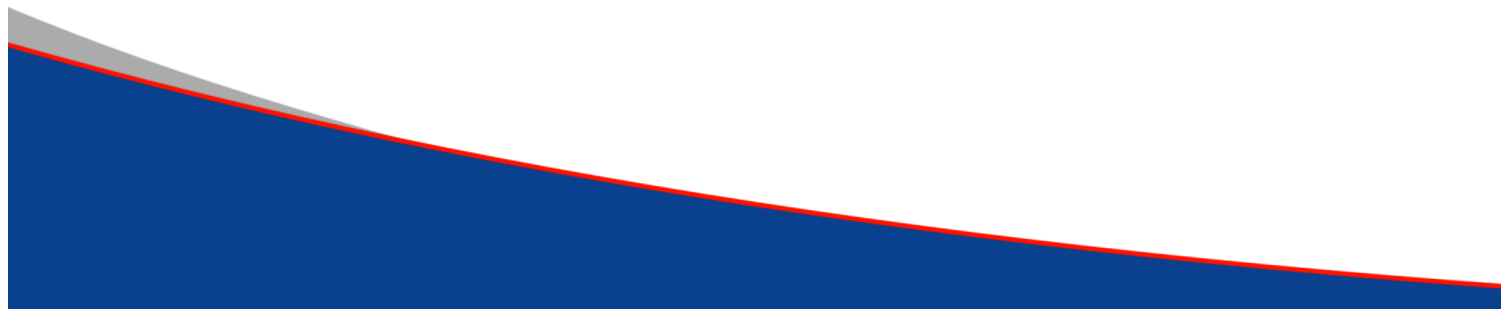
And I would add listen to the words of Jesus and follow His way of love

WHAT IS PENTECOST?

The holy feast day of Pentecost occurs fifty days after Easter and marks Christ's gift of the Holy Spirit to his followers. On that day long ago there was the sound of wind, the flickering of tongues of flame, and the babel of many different voices. This experience became the official birthday of the Christian church.





WHAT IS TRINITY SUNDAY?

Trinity Sunday, the first Sunday after Pentecost, honors the Holy Trinity—the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Although the word “trinity” does not appear in Scripture, it is taught in Matthew 28:18-20 and 2 Corinthians 13:14 (and many other biblical passages). It lasts only one day, which is symbolic of the unity of the Trinity. Western Christians have observed the Sunday after Pentecost as a time to pause and reflect on the Christian understanding of God.
